- Date:** Saturday, October 11, 2008
- Start:** 6:30 A.M. Lake Chabot Marina, Castro Valley, CA
- Course:** Out-and-back course, mostly along the legendary East Bay Skyline National Trail; Fireroads and single tract with gorgeous views of San Francisco and Mt. Diablo. Approximately 9,000 feet of climb.
- Time Limit:** 13 hour time limit. Cut-off times: 26 miles (6:15) & 41.5 miles (10:30).
- Aid:** Fourteen aid-stations scattered along the course. It can be warm; it is highly recommended that you carry a water container during the race.
- Entry Fee:** \$85.00 if postmarked by 9/06/08, \$100.00 if received by 10/04/08. All entries received after 10/04/06 will be returned. Race day registration will be available. Race Day Fee: \$120.00. Make Checks payable to: Ann Trason.

- Refunds:** No refunds after September 1st. In the event that the race is cancelled due to park closure or other unforeseen circumstances, partial refunds may be granted, but only to the extent funds are still available at the time of cancellation.
- Additional info:** Additional race information & race numbers will be mailed to entrants on September 29th. Entries received after 9/27 must pick-up race number, at race day registration, between 5:30-6:15 a.m. at Cove Picnic Area at the Lake Chabot Marina.
